Label the ones you know on this map. Colour in the map.



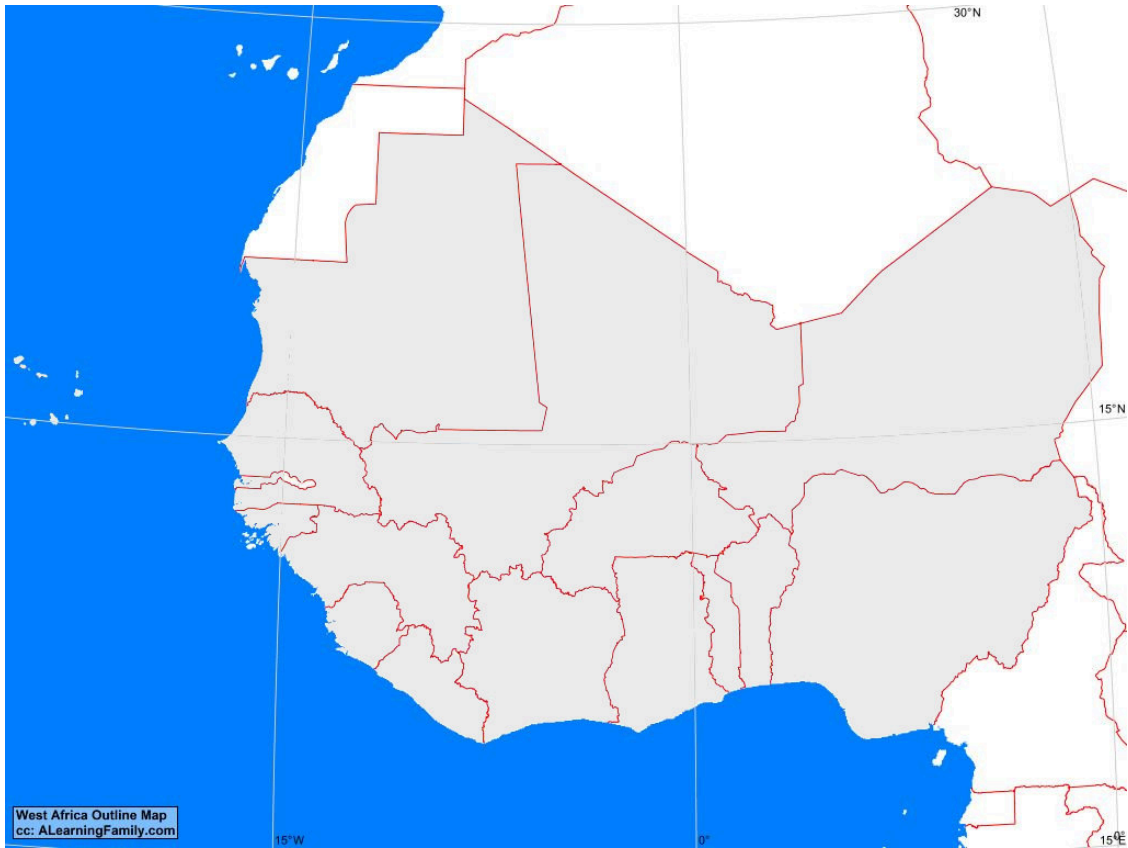
Is anyone able, without looking it up, to point to the country called Sierra Leone?
